What is the exhibition all about?

Each year, Link Wentworth holds an art exhibition that focuses on the importance of our 'home'. It's called 'No Place Like Home'.

The exhibition came about because Link Wentworth and its residents wanted to highlight the importance of safe and secure housing and show how a 'home' can transform lives. Over the few years that this event has been held, people have responded to the theme by expressing what a home means to them through a variety of artworks.

The exhibition also raises awareness about the lack of affordable housing in Sydney and the need for more community housing.

Who can submit work?

So many Link Wentworth residents have creative talents and are interested in art, so this exhibition offers a great way for them to showcase their work.

Link Wentworth knows that many other people in the local community also support social and affordable housing - so we encourage them to support the exhibition by submitting their work too. Link Wentworth aims to build connected communities and these arts shows are a great opportunity to bring the community together.

Do you have to be a professional artist to submit work?

Definitely not – the exhibition is open to all. It's an excellent opportunity for both budding and professional artists living in Link Wentworth properties to showcase their talent and passion. Other artists are also welcome to submit their work.

Who attends the exhibition?

The exhibition attracts a mix of art lovers, community leaders, tenants and the general public. The exhibition travels between several venues including professional art galleries and public spaces, so it's open to everyone to attend.

Which artists have been featured previously?

In previous years we had artworks from well-known, Sydney-based artist Jane Bennett, and other professional artists including Julie Peardon, Ting Ying Chang, Joo Ri Moon, Goya Torres and so many more.

How do you select the artist and artworks to exhibit?

Link Wentworth will do their best to showcase all pieces of art that are submitted. However, if the gallery space is too small to show all entries, we will let you know. Priority will be given to works submitted by Link Wentworth residents.
